6.	Paul repeats the call to "not lose heart" (4:1,16), what are the reasons for this hope?
7.	How can Paul's longing (5:1-3) for his heavenly dwelling inspire your own perspective on life and death?
8.	How does the Holy Spirit give us a foretaste of heavenly joy that sustains us while we go through hardships? (5:5)
9.	How should our future resurrection bodies motivate us to please God daily (5:8-10)?
