1. *And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires. 2 Peter 1:4*
2. *For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. Jeremiah 29:11*

They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint. Isaiah 40:29-31*
5. *And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19*
6. *No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us. And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:37-39*
7. *But all who listen to me will live in peace, untroubled by fear of harm.” Proverbs 1:33*
8. *“I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.” John 14:27*
9. *If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9*
10. *For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23*
11. *The Lord is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made. Psalm 145:9*
12. *Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever. 1 Chronicles 16:34*
13. *For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations. Psalm 100:5*
14. *Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. James 1:17*

15. *Sovereign Lord, you are God! Your covenant is trustworthy, and you have promised these good things to your servant.* 2 Samuel 7:28
16. *The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple.* Psalm 19:7

21. *But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.* Isaiah 40:31
22. *When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.* Isaiah 43:2
23. *So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.* Matthew 6:31-33
24. *Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.* Proverbs 3:5-6
